




#### **Structure of the NPPO**




#### Plant Protection Station network in Japan



#### Plant Quarantine System in Japan













## ARTICLE IV: Measures to Exclude South American Leaf Blight of Hevea from the Region

...the Contracting Governments shall take the measures specified in Appendix B to this Agreement. Appendix B to this Agreement may be modified by a decision of the Commission taken unanimously.

#### **APPENDIX B**

Each Contracting Government shall prohibit by law the importation into its territory or territories of any plant or plants of the genus Hevea from outside the Region ...

#### Development of compliance with SPS Agreement

999: 21<sup>st</sup> session of APPPC adopted the Amendments to delete Article XIV and APPENDIX B and circulation after adoption of satisfactory RSPM related to SALB.

2007: 25th session of APPPC adopted Pest risk analysis for SALB.

2008: Draft RSPM "Guidelines for protection against South American Leaf Blight of rubber" was sent for member consultation.
