Notification of Department of Agriculture

Entitled: Determination of Details, Criteria and Procedure for Registration, Issuance and Extension of Hazardous Substances Registration Certificate under the Responsibility of Department of Agriculture (No. 3) B.E. 2554 (2011)

Subsequent to issuance of Ministry of Agriculture and Cooperatives Entitled Registration, Issuance and Extension of Hazardous Substance Registration Certificate under Responsibility of Department of Agriculture B.E. 2551(2008), the criteria and procedure for registration of hazardous substance had been determined.

In order to facilitate registration and the implementation of trade name, by virtue of the above-mentioned Notification, the Director-General of Department of Agriculture issued the following announcements.

No. 1 The importer or producer shall register one formulation of hazardous substance in not more than three trade names. Every trade name is required to apply for registration.

Registered importer or producer referred in paragraph one, who wish to apply for registration of the same formulation of hazardous substance in other trade names (second and third trade names) is exempted from submission of efficacy data and data required in the attachment of Notification of Department of Agriculture Entitled: Details of Criteria and Procedure for Registration, Issuance and Extension of Hazardous Substances Registration Certificate under the Responsibility of Department of Agriculture B.E. 2552 (2009).

Exemption from submission of data referred in paragraph two shall apply only in case of registration of hazardous substance from the same producer.

No. 2 Trade name of hazardous substance shall be characterized as follows.

2.1 The trade name shall not be identical or similar to His Majesty the King, Her Majesty the Queen or Royal Family names;

2.2 trade name shall not be contained with impolite word or phase

2.3 The trade name shall not be in duplication, or the same as or similarity to the trade name of hazardous substance used by the other no matter of its whether being legally registered under trademark law or not;

2.4 The trade name shall be the wording or phase that is not antagonistic to the society and morality of the people;

2.5 The trade name shall not be the wording or phase that is directly interpreted by its characteristics or property of hazardous substance.

This Notification is effective since one day after it is published in the Government Gazette.
