Regulation of the Department of Agriculture
on
Checking of Documents Required for Registration of Hazardous Substance
under Responsible of the Department of Agriculture
(No. 2) B.E. 2554 (2011)

Upon the Department of Agriculture has already issued the Regulation on Checking Documents Required for Registration of Hazardous Substance under Responsibility of Department of Agriculture B.E. 2553 (2010), in order to allow checking of document to be quickly and efficiently, the Director-General of Department of Agriculture issued the regulation as follows.

No. 1 This Regulation is called “Regulation of the Department of Agriculture on Checking of Documents Required for Registration of Hazardous Substance under Responsible of the Department of Agriculture (No.2) B.E. 2554 (2011).”

No. 2 This regulation shall be effective since the date issued.

No.3 To repeal the provision in No. 6 of the Regulation on Checking Documents Required for Registration of Hazardous Substance under Responsibility of Department of Agriculture B.E. 2553 (2010) and replaced by the following provision.

“No. 6 The documents referred to in No. 5, except the documents referred to in No. 4, which were prepared in foreign country shall be legalized and signed by competent officer of the Thai embassy or consular in such a country not exceeding 6 months prior to the date of submission of the application.”
