Notification of Department of Agriculture
Entitled Details of Criteria and Procedure for Registration, Issuance and
Extension of Hazardous Substances Registration Certificate under the
Responsibility of Department of Agriculture (No. 3) B.E. 2554 (2011)

According to Notification of Ministry of Agriculture and Cooperatives Entitled Registration, Issuance and Extension of Hazardous Substance Registration Certificate under Responsibility of Department of Agriculture B.E. 2551(2008), the criteria and procedure for hazardous substance registration have been determined.

In order to facilitate registration and the application of trade name in the registration of hazardous substance under Hazardous Substance Act B.E. 2535 (1992) and its amendments to be expeditiously and efficiently, by virtue of the above-mentioned Notification, the Director-General of Department of Agriculture issued announcement as follows:

No. 1 Importer or producer of hazardous substance is allowed to register 1 formulation of hazardous substance not more than 3 trade names. Each trade name is required to register.

Importer or producer already registered referred to in paragraph one, if desire to register for the second or third trade name, is exempted from efficacy test and submission of technical information in the data requirement for registration of hazardous substance attached to Notification of Department of Agriculture entitled Details of Criteria and Procedure for Registration, Issuance and Extension of Hazardous Substances Registration Certificate under the Responsibility of Department of Agriculture B.E. 2552 (2009) but it is required to submit a copy of the registration certificate of first trade name.

The exemption for submission of information referred to in paragraph two, manufacturing source in the application for registration of hazardous substance must be the same.

No. 2 The trade name of agricultural hazardous substance shall be characterized as follows:

2.1 It shall not be identical or similar to His Majesty the King, Her Majesty the Queen or Royal Family names;

2.2 It shall not contain impolite word or phrase;

2.3 It shall not be in duplication, or the same as or similar to the trade name of hazardous substance used by the other whether it is legally registered under trademark law or not;

2.4 It shall be in the word or phrase that is not contradict to the peace and morality of the people;

2.5 It shall not be in the word or phase that is directly interpreted by its characteristics or property of hazardous substance.

This Notification is effective one day after it is announced in the Government Gazette onward.
