#### **Country Details**


- Number of Phytosanitary Certificates issued in 2013: 20,874
- Number of Phytosanitary Certificates received in 2013: 211,492
- Number of Re-export Phytosanitary Certificates issued in 2013: 1,029
  - all hard copy (paper) certificates
  - system to produce phytosanitary certificates electronically




## Future single-window import/export

### Challenges for ePhyto in Japan - Technical matters

- > "point to point system" or "hub system"
- > Secure Data Exchange Mechanisms
  - Simple Object Access Protocol (SOAP)
- incorporate ePhyto system into NACCS (PQ application system)
  - Data exchange (XML (UN/CEFACT) to NACCS EDI)
  - Code exchange (own codes (e.g. country, origin, plant, treatment, pesticide))
  - Operational mechanism and function (e.g. input /correct /search /delete information in application)



## Challenges for ePhyto in Japan - Legislative and regulatory requirements and budgetary matters

- > revise the regulation
- budget to develop and incorporate the ePhyto system into NACCS
