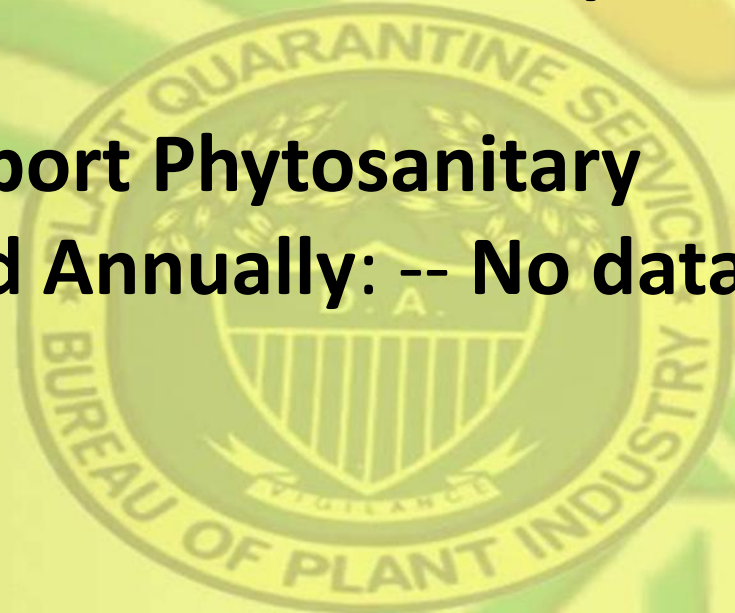

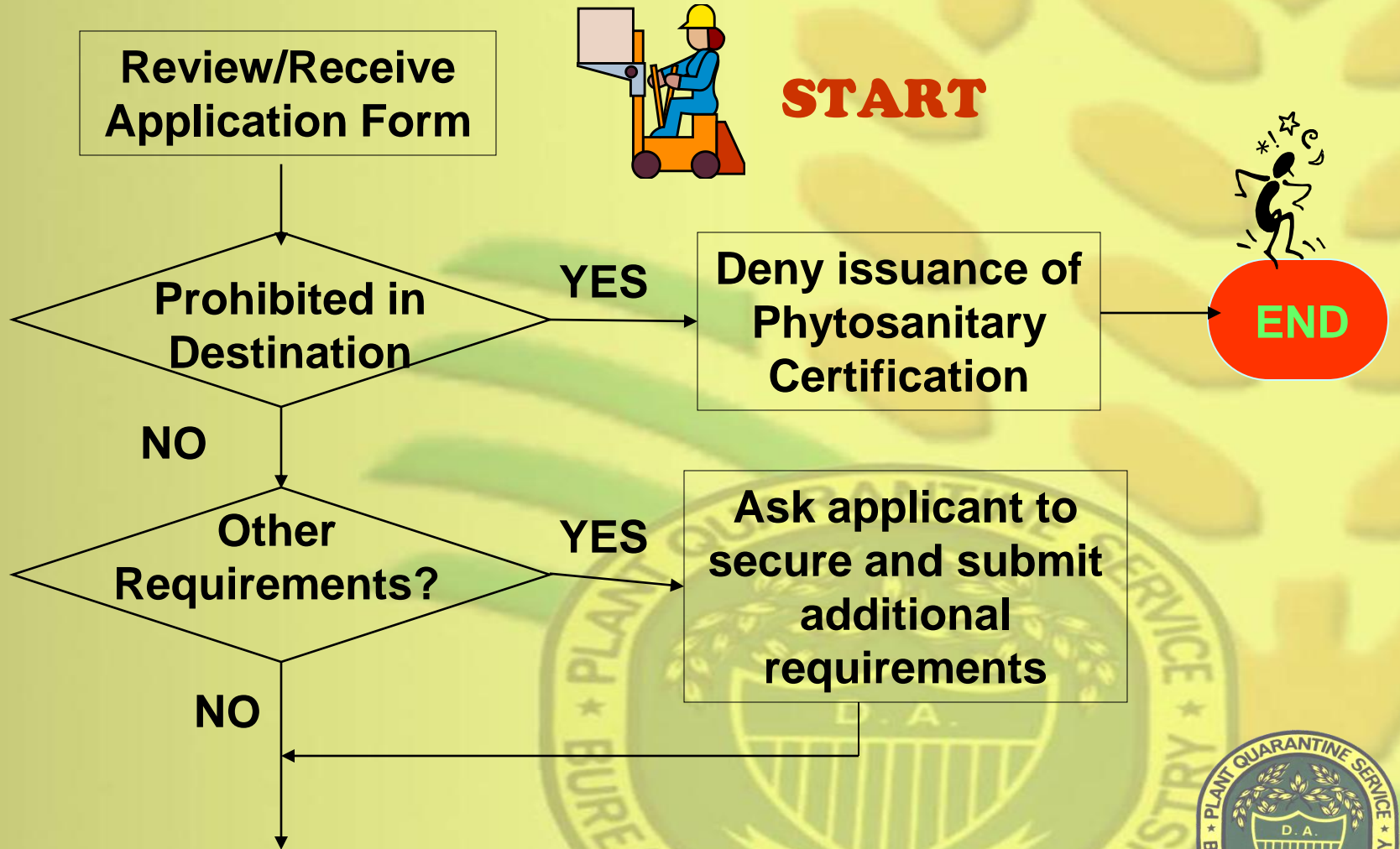

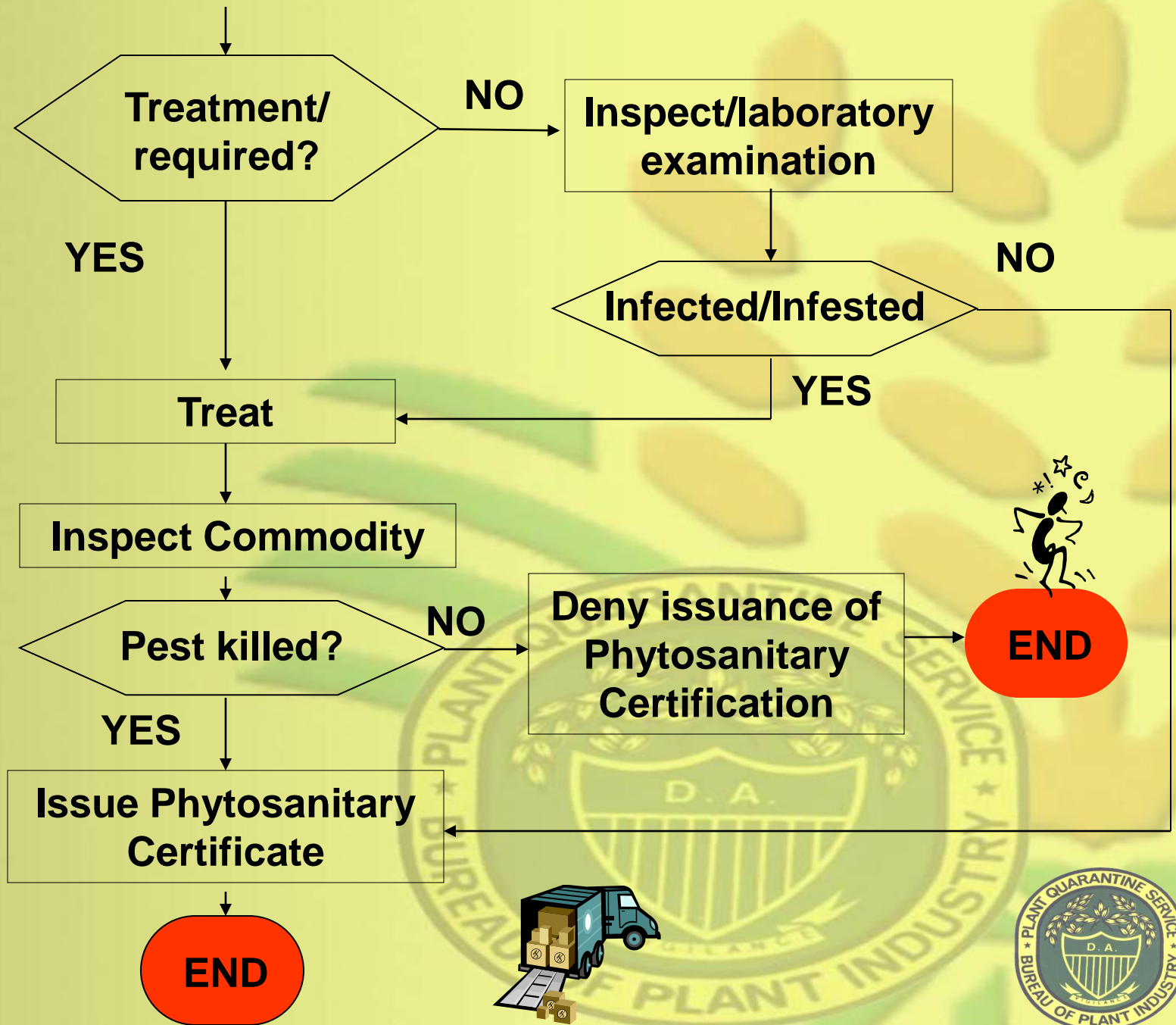

Sample Philippines Phytosanitary Certificate



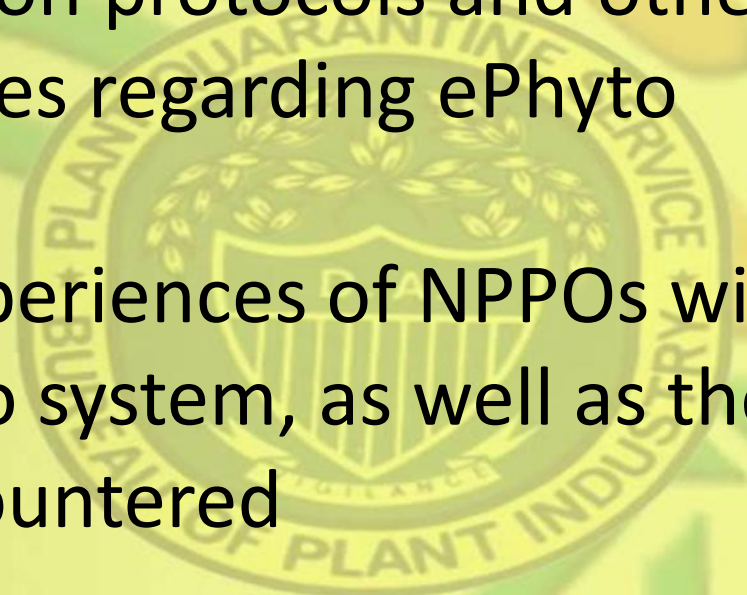
Issuance of Phytosanitary Certificate
