Background and list of progress


- PRA on SALB adopted by the 25th Session of APPPC, 2007
- RSPM No.7 on SALB was adopted by the 26th Session of APPPC, 2009
- A WG on SALB was established at the 26th Session to develop detailed guidelines to support the SALB Regional Standard-No.7
- The Working Group led by Malaysia with participation of China, India, Indonesia, Philippines, Thailand and Vietnam
- A "Workshop on the Prevention of Introduction of SALB was held in KL, Malaysia, 13-17 Dec. 2010

Objective of the workshop
