Background and list of progress

- PRA on SALB adopted by the 25th Session of APPPC, 2007
 - RSPM No.7 on SALB-adopted by the 26th Session of APPPC, 2009
 - A WG on SALB, established at the 26th Session to develop detailed guidelines to support the SALB Regional Standard-No.7
 - The Working Group led by Malaysia: China, India, Indonesia, Philippines, Thailand and Vietnam
 - A "Workshop on the Prevention of Introduction of SALB, KL, Malaysia, 13-17 Dec. 2010
- Output: Guidelines on importation of requirements for *Hevea* plant material





(cont'l)

- Contingency plan for SALB-prepared at the APPPC workshop on pest incursion and eradication, 30 Aug.-3 Sept. 2010, Korea
- Publication 1-SALB (2011): (*Guidelines for importation/C-plan/PRA*)

- Familiarize SALB reference materials and the measures
- Share knowledge and gain expertise from experts in this field
- Feedback on the use of SALB reference materials for trainers.



Capacity of trainers trained

Trainers are expected to:

- conduct training on SALB to other officers in own country
- use the reference material a core group of competent trainers on SALB and protection of SALB in the region upon the needs of each country
- become the Subject Matter Officers (SMOs) on SALB of each country
- convey information to the higher management level to conduct SALB activities
- review and update on the reference materials from time to time, from the feedback.
